Meet the New Teachers

Miss Wood has been appointed as an Assistant Head Teacher and is a member of the School Leadership Team. She was an Assistant Head in Enfield and has been teaching for 15 years. She is passionate about cross curricular learning and using books as a stimulus for topic work. Miss Wood is the Year 2W Class Teacher and Key Stage 1 Leader.

Mrs Bright is the Year 5B Class Teacher. She has experience of teaching in both primary and secondary schools in Brent and Ealing. She is passionate about enabling children to learn, grow and be the very best they can be.

Mr Wilkinson is the Year 4W Class Teacher. He has been teaching primary and secondary school

children for more than 30 years in a variety of roles. He has a special interest in history.

Miss Baldwin has been teaching for 20 years and her university background is in linguistics and literature. Miss Baldwin will be working in various classes as a Cover Teacher.

Ms Taha will be the Class Teacher for Year 2 on Thursday and Friday. She has been teaching since 1992, both in the UK and abroad. She has taught in Year 2 for several years. She is particularly interested in teaching music and art.

Class Assemblies

Once each year we invite parents in to class assemblies. This is an opportunity for you to see what your child has been learning about as well as an opportunity for children to develop their confidence by speaking in public. Please look out for your child's class assembly in the diary dates each term and come along to these special assemblies – your child would love you to be there! The next class assembly is for Year 6 on the 7th October and will start at 9.00am. Assemblies usually last between 15-20 minutes and refreshments are served at the end.

Secondary School Applications

Year 6 parents please remember to apply online through Hertfordshire County Council for a secondary school place. Applications close on 31st October 2016.

The application will need to be completed on a desk top or laptop computer as users have reported problems when using a phone or tablet. The library at 96 Shenley Road has computers which can be used free of charge.

Attendance

Regular attendance at school is vital to help children achieve and get the best possible start in life. Children should be in school every day unless they are genuinely unwell.

100% attendance is rewarded each month and half term with a mini certificate, which the children enjoy collecting. We also have a raffle each term which all the children with 100% attendance are entered into. In addition we have 'Muffin Mondays', where the class with the best attendance for the week are rewarded with a muffin the following Monday.

Appointments/Absences

Please try and make appointments outside of the school day. When any appointments are booked during school hours, please advise the office as soon as possible and bring in with you an appointment letter or card stating the time and date. Also can I remind you that if your child is unable to attend school you must inform the office on the first day of absence, this can be by text, phone or email. Without reasons for absence we are unable to determine whether or not the absence will be authorised. (All absences are unauthorised if no reason is given).

More than 15 sessions (7.5 days) of unauthorised absence may incur a fixed penalty notice being issued by the Local Education Authority.

Each year, children from Y1 - 6 are elected to represent their class. They will be involved with driving forward initiatives for the school as well as being the pupil voice to improve Parkside even further.

Flu Vaccination

School Health will be coming in to school on Monday 17th October to administer the flu vaccine to children in years 1, 2 and 3. Parents will receive more information along with a consent form closer to the date of the vaccination. The method of vaccination is a nasal spray and not an injection.
