Impact on Attainment:

Outcomes for Year 6 July 2015 Pupil Premium Children.

19 pupil premium children in the cohort. Of those, 18 children were tested in Year 2 which enables us to give a progress measure from Year 2 – Year 6.

Attainment of Pupil Premium children

- 3.7% increase in children's attainment in reading and maths at Level 4
- 17% Dip in children's attainment in writing L4
- Increase in children's writing and maths attainment Level 5
- Decrease in L5 children's attainment in maths

Progress of Pupil Premium Children

- 100% of children progressed by 2 levels or more in reading and writing (91% last year)
- 88.9% of children progressed two levels or more in maths (100% last year)

Glossary

Attainment – levels that children achieve by the time they leave the school. These levels are converted into points known as Average Point Scores

Progress – how much progress the children have made between the ages of 7 and 11.

Pupil Premium children – children in receipt of free school meals at some point in the previous 6 years, looked after children.

FSM (Free School Meals) Children who are currently having Free School Meals
