<u>English</u>


Literacy work will be linked to each topic through the term. The children will be sharing lessons including grammar, handwriting and spelling work. We will be showing our good grammar and spelling through our writing of recounts, myths and legends, poetry and non-chronological reports. Spelling words will go home weekly and the children will have a spelling test each Friday. *Please help your child to learn their spellings at home.*

Mathematics

During the term the children will be working on number skills, calculations, shapes and measure, data handling and word problems. We will be practicing our skills of partitioning larger numbers and using this to help us with our calculations. We will use our mental calculation skills to add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers. In shape we will continue to learn 2D and 3D shapes and symmetry. We will be practicing different ways of measuring including time. Through all of this we will solve problems in different contexts.

Fruit

The children no longer receive fruit from the government scheme in the juniors, so we ask that you supply your child daily with fruit if you wish to do so. The children will really benefit from this boost mid-morning. Please speak to us about this if you have any questions, thank you.



<u>Homework</u> Spelling homework will be sent home every Friday and needs to be back in school the following Friday. Learning Log homework along with Maths homework will be sent home every other Monday. You will have two weeks to complete and a due date will always be given. Please read daily with your children and complete their reading records.

During the second half of the term, we will be learning about Rocks and soils in our science lessons.
