
English

Literacy work will be linked to each topic throughout the term. The children will be exploring different genres of fiction and non-fiction, including explanation texts and poetry. Our focus this year will be on spelling, punctuation and grammar, and the children will receive weekly spelling tests. They will be tested on a Friday. Please help your child to learn their spellings at home.



Mathematics

During the term the children will be working on place value, number skills, calculating, shapes, data handling and measuring. The children will be using their number facts to add and subtract and we will be focusing on the 3,4,6,7,9 times table. The children will also learn different ways to multiply and divide numbers. The children will be looking at measure and converting between different units. The children will also be calculating perimeter of shapes. They will also be using their problem solving skills. They will also be looking graphs and interrupting data.



PSHE

We will be following the Jigsaw programme. We will be starting with Being Me in My World.

PE

Children will need their PE kit in school everyday, it should consist of a white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers or plimsolls. Children should be provided with suitable clothing for taking part in outdoor PE. Children should remove their earrings for PE days and long hair should be tied up. This term, Aspen will swim Wednesdays until Feb half term. Rowan will then begin their swimming lessons. Both classes will have their PE lesson on Thursday.



Homework

Learning logs are projects which help your child to become more creative and investigative. These will take place over a 2 week periods. Maths will be given out at the same time. Spelling words will be given weekly.

Topic

For the first half of the term we will be learning about Robots. We will be learning to build a simple circuit. In the second half of this term, the children will be learning about the Anglo Saxons.

Computing.
