You will need to explain what muscles you are working and why it is important to warm up before exercising. Limit resources – use what you have seen during PE sessions.</p>

Write a review of your favourite app/game that you like to play to share with the class. What makes the app enjoyable? Is it easy to use? How could it be improved?</p>

Include details about their life cycle, diet, habitat, appearance and interesting facts about them.</p>

Label the countries that can be found within this continent and write some interesting facts about them (flags, capital cities etc.).</p>
