What do you see? How does it make you feel?</p>
<p><u>Activity 3 (Maths)</u> Log on to Education city and complete 3 maths activities</p>	<p><u>Activity 4 (English)</u> Login to Education city and complete 3 English activities</p>
<p><u>Activity 5 (PE)</u> Write out an exercise routine including star jumps, jogging on the spot, stair climb etc.</p>	<p><u>Activity 6 (ART)</u> Draw or paint a still-life picture of spring flowers.</p>
<p><u>Activity 7 (Science)</u> Create a weather diary for a week. Record what the weather was like with sentences or draw symbols. How did you feel when they saw Jesus again?</p>	<p><u>Activity 10 (DT)</u> Do some Easter cooking or baking. Can you make biscuits, cakes or Easter nests?</p>
