*(only one)*

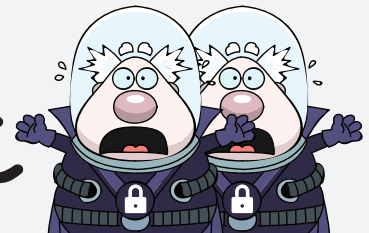
*villain*



*Nouns can be plural*

*(more than one)*

*villains*



# SUPER SPELLING TIPS - Plural nouns

**W**e can make most nouns plural by adding 's' to the end.

singular	plural
cake	cake <i>s</i>
drink	drink <i>s</i>
tree	tree <i>s</i>
horse	horse <i>s</i>
comic	comic <i>s</i>
book	book <i>s</i>
cape	cape <i>s</i>
villain	villain <i>s</i>



# ***SUPER SPELLING TIPS** - Plural nouns*

**I**f a noun ends in ch, sh,  
s, ss or x we  
*usually add 'es'*  
to make it plural.

wishes

kisses

lunches

buses

foxes



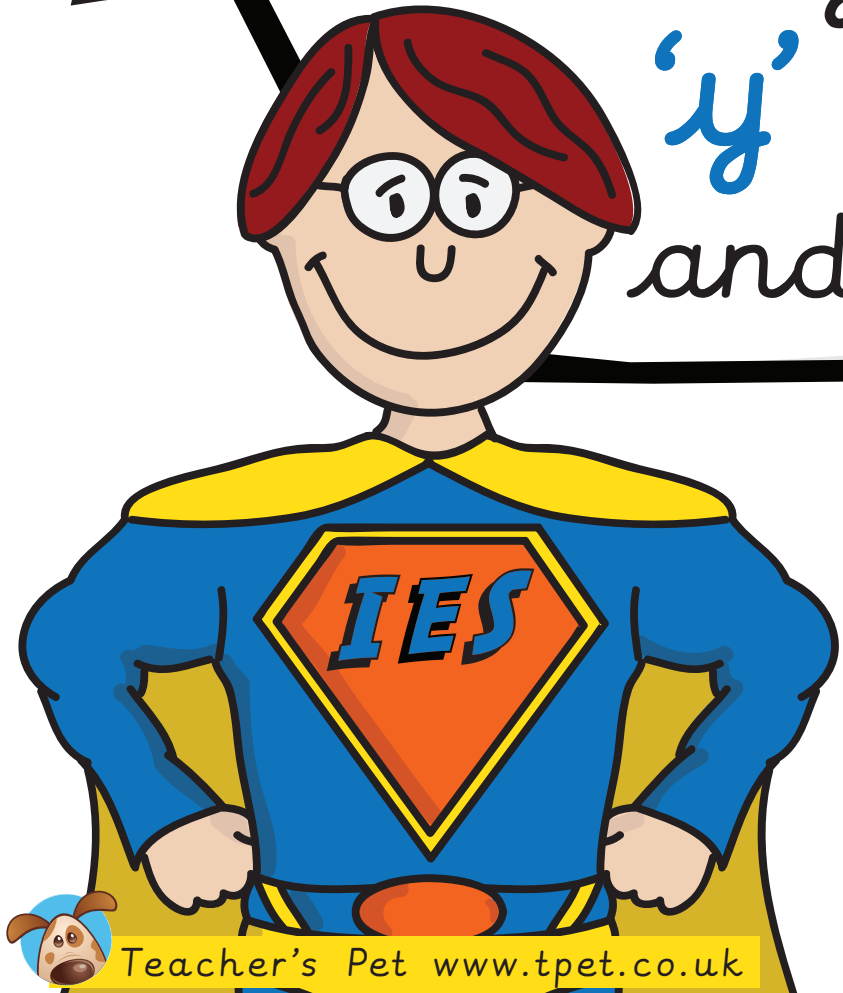
# SUPER SPELLING TIPS - Plural nouns

**I**f a noun ends in a consonant and a 'y', we **swap** the 'y' for an 'i' and **add 'es'**.

memory > memories

story > stories

baby > babies



# ***SUPER SPELLING TIPS** - Plural nouns*

child > children      mouse > mice  
leaf > leaves      goose > geese  
man > men      person > people

**S**ome tricky nouns  
don't follow  
any of these rules.  
You just have to learn  
them by heart.
