### Before watching the film:

- What does the word Soar mean? To reach a height.
- Can we think of synonyms for soar? Ascend, escalate.
- What do you think the film is going to be about? A struggling pilot.

## Pause the film after 48 seconds as she rests her head on her hand.

- Do you think this is the first time the girl has tried to make the plane fly? No. She has a plan.
- What do you think she is thinking as it flies/crashes? It could work this time.
- How is she feeling as she sits at the desk? Why isn't this working?

## Pause the film 1m 17s (when we see their first reaction to each other)

- What do you think she thought when the bag landed? What is that? Who was that?
- Did this change when she saw the plane? No.
- How does the little man feel about the girl? Why is she so big?.
- What do you think she would say to him? What is happening?

### Pause the film at 1m 35s when he realises that his airship is broken.

- Is the little man in a hurry? Why? Yes. He crashed and wants to go back.
- Where do you think he is going? Back to his home.
- Do you think this was a planned stop? No. It was an accidental crash.
- How is he feeling at this point? Like he should have been more careful and is worried.

• Why did the director show the girl trying to make her own flying machine in the opening scenes? To show her love for planes

## Pause the film at 2m 50s as he watches the other flying machines disappear over the horizon.

- How do you think the little man is feeling now? I need to get up there.
- What time of day is it? Dusk.

### Watch the next 25 seconds and pause on the girl slouching against the rock.

- What do you think they are saying to each other now? I'm sorry I tried to help.
- How is she feeling? How do we know? Unaccomplished. She slouches I defeat.
- Will they give up? No. They will keep on trying.
- What do you think is on the blue paper? Her plan to build a flying machine.

# Watch the film until the end.

- What is the job of the small flying men? To put the stars in the sky at night.
- What could we call them? Night Glinters.

• How do you think the girl is feeling as she looks up at the stars at the end? Accomplished and helpful.
