Dear Parents and Carers,

START AND FINISH TIMES FOR ALL GROUPS

To ensure that social distancing is maintained it is extremely important that children are dropped off and collected promptly at their allotted time. Please aim to arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before their start time. Children should not arrive late under any circumstances.

No parents will be allowed to enter the school grounds at drop off and pick up.

Year 1 – Children should be dropped off and collected from the Allerton Road gate. Start time 9.10am pick up time 3.15pm. Friday pick up time 1pm

Year 6 - Children should be dropped off and collected from the Allerton Road gate. Start time 9.00am pick up time 3pm. Friday pick up time 1.15pm

Key worker/vulnerable children – Children should be dropped off and collected from the Allerton Road gate. Start time 8.45am pick up time 3.15pm. Friday pick up time 1.15pm


PACKS OF WORK
