Whatever Next! by Jill Murphy

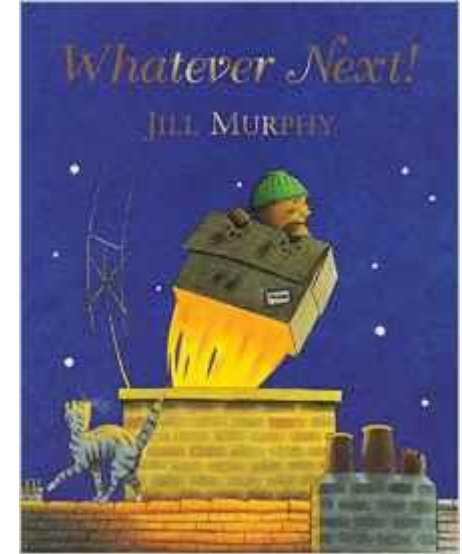

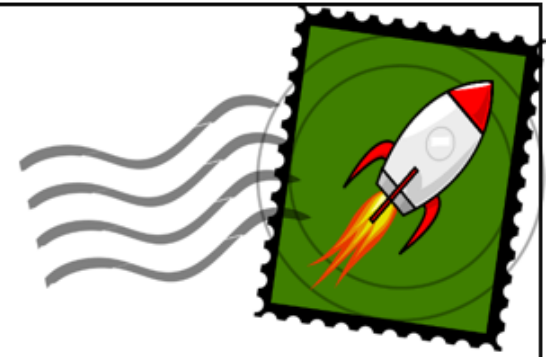
After that, see if you can help to tell your grown up where the words should go, on the next slide. Which spelling for the sound 'ay' comes up most often?
