As part of our standards cup, children will help their class to earn points by completing their homework. You will need to explain what muscles you are working and why it is important to warm up before exercising. Limit resources – use what you have seen during PE sessions.</p>
<p><u>Activity 3</u></p> <p>Read a book and write a detailed book review. Give a short summary of the story and the characters. Remember to give the book a rating too.</p>	<p><u>Activity 4</u></p> <p>Do you like playing computer games? Write a review of your favourite app/game that you like to play to share with the class. What makes the app enjoyable? Is it easy to use? How could it be improved?</p>
<p><u>Activity 5</u></p> <p>Create a map of a continent of your choice. Label the countries that can be found within this continent and write some interesting facts about them (flags, capital cities, time zones etc.).</p>	<p><u>Activity 6</u></p> <p>Write a clear explanation of why Australia has different seasons to the UK. Explain also why they have daylight while it is night time here. Use diagrams/pictures to help you explain.</p>
<p><u>Activity 7</u></p> <p>Create your own model or labelled diagram of the human heart. Write a clear explanation of how it works.</p>	<p><u>Activity 8</u></p> <p>It is important that we look after our hearts. Create a leaflet or poster giving tips of ways to keep your heart healthy and the consequences of not looking after your heart.</p>
<p><u>Activity 9</u></p> <p>Create a maths game to teach Year 4 and 5 about place value of numbers to 1,000,000.</p>	<p><u>Activity 10</u></p> <p>Something of your own choice.</p>
