Older children who have permission to walk home will continue to leave school at 3:00pm via the single gate that leads on to Aycliffe Road. Brothers and sisters of younger children will meet parents / carers at the respective collection points at the end of the day. For example if a family has a child in Year 6, Year 2 and Reception all three children will be collected from the Reception class collection point.

It is our hope that by reopening the school to parents and carers at the end of the day, the school will begin to return to a normal routine as possible.

In order to avoid any unnecessary incidents it is important that everyone abides by the rules when collecting their child so that this important and quite often lovely part of the day runs as smoothly as possible. Whilst the wearing of a face covering is not statutory in public spaces we would encourage as many of you as possible to wear one when you collect your child.

We look forward to welcoming you back on to the school grounds from MONDAY 26th APRIL from 3:00pm.
