Write down the changes that happen to the materials used throughout the process of making the cake/cookies. Do not forget to take a picture of the final product!</p>

Think about what the climate is like, what sorts of fruit, vegetables grow there, and how it might be different from the UK.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 6</u></p> <p>Create a model of what the inside of a Cotton Factory might look like during the Industrial Revolution. You may need to do some research before you get started.</p>

Create a poster about it and explain what that invention is like in the 21st Century (today).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 8</u></p> <p>In RE, we are learning all about special books. Find a book that is special to you. Take a picture of you with your special book and explain, using a few sentences, why it is special to you.</p>
