We have changed our homework format slightly. The activities will now be more about spending time together as a family. You may decide to take some photos of the activities you do and upload them onto the Google Classroom under the 'Homework' section or to stick the photos in their homework books. Other tasks can be brought into school as they are completed to share with the class. All homework will need to be handed in by Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022. Pupils will still be expected to read daily and learn their weekly spellings.

<p><b>Activity 7</b> <b>Do the research and answer the following questions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Which is the rarest type of rock? Why is it rare?</li> <li>• How many different types of sedimentary rock are there in the UK? How many in the world?</li> </ul>	<p><b>Activity 8</b> Make a salad or a healthy snack with your parents . Write your recipe neatly and tell the nutrients contents of your ingredients.</p>
<p><b>Activity 9</b> Write an email to your teacher and inform her about your memories of Year 3? What did you enjoy the most in Year 3?</p>	<p><b>Activity 10</b> Create your own one outdoor and one indoor game and write its instructions.</p>
