<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 1</u></p> <p>Investigate a variety of amphibian life around the world and create an information poster about it.</p> <p><i>Think about including:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - describe their lifecycle and how it is different to other animals. - how long do they live for? - how long is each stage of their lifecycle? 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 2</u></p> <p>We will be learning about Julius Caesar, Cassius and Brutus in our History topic. Carry out some research about them and write a report about them.</p> <p><i>Think about including:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - who were they and why are they famous? - where did they live and how long ago?
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 3</u></p> <p>Research into someone or an organisation who is helping to protect endangered animals and write a report about it.</p> <p><i>Think about including:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - which species of animal are they trying to protect? - how are they doing this? - what impact have they had so far? 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 4</u></p> <p>Make a 3D model of a Roman chariot or catapult.</p> <p>Think about which materials would be the most suitable.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 5</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Create a positivity jar.</p> <p>This jar can be filled with positive words and comments. The purpose of the jar is to use it whenever you are feeling sad and need to remember all the positive things about yourself such as 'I am kind, I am courageous, I am a good friend.'</p> <p>You can use a jam jar, a coffee jar or a large glass storage jar. Decorate the jar however you wish. Take your time decorating your jar and then decide what slips you are going to put in it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 6</u></p> <p>Research some facts about the Jewish festival of Rosh Hashanah. Create a leaflet about it, including some images of important symbols of the festival.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 7</u></p> <p>Design a poster to tell people how to be safe when online. Make sure you include 'SMART' in your poster.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 8</u></p> <p>Create a maths poster to teach a Year 4 child about place value of numbers to 10,000.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 9</u></p> <p>Read a book and write a detailed book review. Give a short summary of the story and the characters. Remember to give the book a rating too.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 10</u></p> <p>Be creative! Can you come up with your own piece of homework based on something you have been learning at school?</p>
