The internet has some games board outlines which you can use.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 2</u></p> <p>Create stick puppets of the characters from your favourite book/ story.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 3</u></p> <p>Get your heart racing by doing 10 minutes of exercise linked to our daily PE lessons. Think of as many different ways to travel as you can. e.g skipping, hopping, jumping.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 4</u></p> <p>Draw and label 5 magnets used in everyday life in your home.</p>

Include timings from the 24-hour clock and use adverbials of time (first, next, then, after, finally).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 6</u></p> <p>Write a persuasive letter to a person/organisation/thing of choice using the features of a persuasive letter.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 7</u></p> <p>Write a report about different types of settlements.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 8</u></p> <p>Go shopping with one of your adults and try to mentally work out what the final amount will be. You could always round the amounts up or down to give you an estimate.</p>

How will people travel around? Where will people live? Where will people work? Where will energy come from? What services will people need? Will the settlement be a nice place to live?
