<u>Activity 3</u> Practise your joined up handwriting by writing a letter to Mrs Weinstein about your favourite thing in school.	<u>Activity 4</u> Practice mixing colours and close observational drawing. Look at drawing by the artist Durer.
<u>Activity 5</u> Make a race track out of 3 different materials and see which one is the fastest.	<u>Activity 6</u> Make houses out of different materials and then test which one can withstand a flood the best.
<u>Activity 7</u> Write a recount of what you did on the Christmas break. Use time words and try to include exclamation marks and commas.	<u>Activity 8</u> Go on a materials hunt around your house. What can you find? What are the properties?
<u>Activity 9</u> Practise adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers. Draw the tens and ones to help you.	<u>Activity 10</u> An activity of your own choice
