Think about how you will clearly break up the processes and the different ways you can multiply and divide.</p>

Research a mountain range of your choice and make a tourist leaflet to give facts about it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 6</u></p> <p>Create your own robot, inspired by the robot Roz. Create a fact file about it. What are its strengths, weaknesses? What is it made from? How does it communicate? What is its purpose?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 7</u></p> <p>Create a 3D model of a mountain. You could use a cardboard box, plastercine, salt dough or even Paper Mache! Have fun and get creative!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Activity 8</u></p> <p>Research a famous mountaineer and create a fact file about them. Which mountain did they conquer? When did they do this? Did they survive? How long did it take them?</p>
