| <u>Activity 1</u> In History, we are learning about WWII. Research one of the main leaders during WWII. Prepare a presentation to present to the class during our History lessons. | <u>Activity 2</u> Create a times table poster to help you and others to learn their times tables. Think about the patterns that appear within tables and how you can illustrate these patterns. |
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| Activity 3 In English, we are looking at the story of Rose Blanche. Pretend you are a child living during WWII. Write a diary entry pretending that you are living during this time. What would life be like? Remember to practise using your literary devices in your writing. | <u>Activity 4</u> In Science this term we are looking at electricity. Write a set of instructions on how to build an electrical circuit. |
| <u>Activity 5</u> In PSHE we are learning about our dreams and aspirations. Think about your future goals. Research a career you are interested in exploring in the future. | <u>Activity 6</u> Create your own recipe. You can make it at home and take photos. Write a list of the ingredients you used and the quantities. Make sure you include the units of measure. |
| <u>Activity 7</u> In DT we will design and make a toy boat. Design your dream boat. What features would it include? What would you have onboard? | <u>Activity 8</u> Challenge yourself to complete and master two or more areas on SATs bootcamp. |
| <u>Activity 9</u> Use 2Animate and the 2Do I have set to take your own pictures and adapt them to create your own Augmented Reality (AR) video. | <u>Activity 10</u> Something of your own choice. |
